

New Software Releases:


In response to customer suggestions and feature requests, we released **201** new software builds of **Ecclesiact**[®] in the first six months of 2011 alone – a new record!



New Features Improvements:

- 1. Multi-language capabilities extended All pages, postings and layouts can have parallel content for visitors in multiple languages: Home | Sign In | Text Size | Français
- Drag-and-Drop Ordering of Buttons this was a big move forwards for us, and not just because no other CMS can do it!

- Excel export from all reports now functions better and much faster. If you applied filters, sorting or specific selections in a report from your browser, all settings are preserved when you click 'Export to Excel' – suggested by Kim
- 4. Extra Paging Controls added to bottom of reports suggested by Darlene

- 6. **Improvements to Paypal Gateway:** now if someone pays for something with Paypal but funds don't clear immediately, the order status updates automatically the moment they do – *requested by Lori*
